

**W. David Augustyniak** January 22, 1953 - January 29, 2016

W. David Augustyniak, 63 years old of Decatur, Indiana, passed away on Friday, January 29, 2016 in the Lutheran Hospital of Indiana located in Fort Wayne following a brief illness diagnosed on Monday.

He was born on January 22, 1953 in Fort Wayne, Indiana, the son of the late Walter Augustyniak (he passed away October 20, 2005) and Barbara (Reese) Augustyniak (she survives). Dave was united in marriage to Louann Scherer on August 6, 1976 at St. John Lutheran Church - Bingen and she survives.

Dave was a member of the St. Lutheran Church - Bingen. He was also a member of Teamsters Local #414 in Fort Wayne, IN.
