Funeral services will be held Tuesday for John H. Reed, 81, retired farmer, who died suddenly Saturday afternoon of a heart attack at his home 345 North Tenth street. Services will be held at 10:30 o'clock Tuesday morning at the First Methodist church, with Dr. M. O. Lester officiating. Burial will be in the Reynolds cemetery. The deceased was born in Cleveland, O., September 14, 1862 the son of John H. and Mathilda Spangler-Reed. He had never married. He was a member of the First Methodist church. Only survivors are two sisters, Miss Polly Reed of Decatur and Mrs. Mathilda Showers of Chicago. Two brothers, two half-brothers and a half-sister are deceased. The body was removed from the Zwick funeral home to the residence Sunday evening.
