John P. Bosse, 71, funeral Monday

John P. Bosse, 71, 804 Nuttman Ave., retired Pennsylvania Railroad worker and W.W. 1 veteran, died at 7:30 a.m. Friday in the Lawton Nursing Home, Fort Wayne. He had been a patient there and at the VA hospital since breaking his hip last April. He was born in Adams Count January 16, 1895, the son of Frank and Elizabeth Scheathe-Bosse and had resided in this area his entire lifetime. He retired from the Pennsylvania Railroad in 1958 after 43 years of service.

Mr. Bosse was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church the Holy Name Sodality, and Adams County Post 43 American Legion.

Surviving are one brother; Herman Bosse of route 4, Decatur, three sisters, Mrs. Hilda Burke of Cincinnati, Ohio, Mrs. William (Edna) Meyers and Mrs. Margaret Noonan, both of route 6, Decatur.
