Wife of Albert Fox Dies Early This Morning
Rites Here Saturday for Mrs. Bertha Fox, 76

Mrs. Bertha Fox, 76, wife of Albert Fox of R.R. 1, Berne, died at 6:30 AM today at the Clinic Hospital in Bluffton, where she had been a patient for three months. She had been in failing health for several years. Death was attributed to cancer. She submitted to surgery three times the last three years.

A lifelong resident of this community, Mrs. Fox was born May 29th 1893, in French Township, a daughter of Louis and Sylvia Twillard Strahm. She was married to Mr. Fox, February 25, 1912, in French Township with vows being received by the late Rev. H. H. Kattman.

Surviving are the husband, former assistant highway superintendent in Adams County, and also formally general foreman of the Bluffton sub district of the State highway Department; three sons, Ervin L. Fox, R.R. 2, Ossian; Howard W. Fox, Fort Wayne, and Gorman D. Fox, R. R. 3, Decatur; 11 grandchildren and one great grandchild and a brother, William Strahm, Decatur. Six brothers, Lewis, Otto, Ernest, Levi, Albert and Philip Strahm and two sisters preceded in death.

The body is at the Yager Funeral Home, where friends may call after 7 PM Thursday and where services will be held at 1:30 PM Saturday Rev. John Dulin, pastor of the St. John's United Church of Christ, of which she was a member, will officiate and burial will be in the MRE Cemetery.
