Herman P. Fox Funeral Held in Berne Today

Furniture Factory Employee For Many Years Dies

Funeral services were held this afternoon at the First Mennonite Church for Herman P. Fox, 60, of Berne R.R. 1. Mr. Fox died at 2:30 pm Saturday, Dec. 16, at the Adams County Memorial Hospital where he was admitted following a stroke. Rev. Gordon Neuenschwander and Rev. Gerald Stucky officiated and burial was in the MRE Cemetery. The Yager Funeral Home had charge of the service.

Mr. Fox, who had been in ill health since September of 1966 when he suffered a stroke, had been in the hospital since last Wednesday when he suffered a massive stroke and he was unconscious since.

He was an upholsterer at Smith Brothers Furniture Factory for approximately 40 years. He was a member of the First Mennonite Church and an active member of the Mens Chorus and the Chancel Choir of the church.

Mr. Fox was born in Berne March 15, 1907, a son of Noah and Lillie Hirschy Fox. He was married to Martha Habegger June 3, 1934, in Berne.

Surviving are the wife; three sons, Edward Fox, Berne; Byron Fox, Tempe, Arizona and David Fox, at home; a daughter, Mrs. Rex (Carol) King, Decatur R.R. 2; five grandchildren; the mother, Mrs. Lillie Fox of Berne; a sister, Mrs. Ben (Dorothy) Harkless, Decatur, R.R. 3 and two brothers, Arthur Fox and James Fox, both of Berne, R.R. 1. The father and a brother, Gordon are deceased.
