### **Joseph Hirschy Dies at Fort Wayne**

Joseph Hirschy, 75, of Fort Wayne, and a native of Monroe Township, died early this morning in St. Joseph Hospital where he had been a patient the past two weeks. He had been ill five months. Death was caused by cancer.

Mr. Hirschy was a son of Ephriam and Lucy Hirschy, both deceased. He has been a resident of Fort Wayne since World War I, locating in that city after returning from service. He was employed in various industries in that city. He retired a few years ago.

Surviving are the wife and the following brothers and sisters: Herman and Theodore of Berne; Menno, James and Ezra of Fort Wayne; Mrs. Herman (Lovina) Haugk of Decatur and Mrs. James (Genevieve) Sullivan of Houston, Texas.

His mother, Mrs. Lucy Hirschy, died last week.

A daughter, Dixie, preceded him in death a few weeks ago.
