HIRSCHY CHILD DIES AT HOME EARLY TODAY

Funeral at Reformed Ch. Saturday for Alfred Hirschy Child

Verna Mae Hirschy, 4-month-old daughter of Alfred Hirschy, died at 6:50 o'clock this morning at the home of her parents, one mile west of the Winchester church northwest of Berne. The child had been ill three weeks with bronchial pneumonia.

Verna Mae Hirschy was born May 19, 1938, bringing her age to 4 months and 19 days. She was the daughter of Alfred and Minnie Burkhart Hirschy.

Surviving are the parents and the following brothers and sisters: Melvin, 18; Glen, 14; Rebecca, 9; Russel, 6; and Ardena, 3. The grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Henry Hirschy, living near the Winchester church, and Mrs. Ed Burkhart, of Blue Creek twp., also survive.

The funeral will be Saturday afternoon at 1 o'clock at the home and at 1:30 o'clock at the Cross Reformed church here, the Rev. C. A. Schmid officiating. Burial will be in the M.R.E. cemetery.
