Otto Lammert, 86, a resident of the Decatur Community Care Center, died at 8:47 a.m. Tuesday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, where he had been a patient since May 30.

Mr. Lammert was a retired employee of the Erie Railroad.

He was a former resident of Pleasant Mills and a member of the Pleasant Mills baptist Church.

Born Dec. 17, 1888, in Preble township, he was the son of William and Elizabeth Scherry-Lammert, and was united in marriage on March 11, 1927 to the former Cora McBarnes, who died May 27, 1972.
