fourteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing forty acres.
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Jeremiah Andrews

several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Jeremiah Andrews
and to his heirs the said tract above described:

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said
Jeremiah Andrews
and to his heirs and assigns forever.
