To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Jeremiah Andrews, of Tresscowas County, Ohio has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Wayne Indiana whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Jeremiah Andrews according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 25th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North East quarter of the South West quarter, of Section thirty three, in Township eight North of Range fourteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing forty acres.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Jeremiah Andrews

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Jeremiah Andrews and to his heirs, the said tract above described. To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Jeremiah Andrews and to his heirs and assigns forever.
