To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Mel Armstrong of Allen County Indiana has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Wayne whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Mel Armstrong according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the Fractional number one of section twenty in Township twenty eight North of Range fourteen East in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana containing thirty eight acres and fifty three hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Mel Armstrong

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Mel Armstrong and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Mel Armstrong and to his heirs and assigns forever.
