To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas *Jacob W. Parks, and Joseph O. Parks, Assignees of Jacob Fitzsimans* have deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Wayne, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Jacob Fitzsimans*, according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter of the North East quarter, of Section thirty-three, in Township twenty-eight North of Range fourteen, East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing forty acres, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Jacob Fitzsimans*.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Jacob W. Parks, and Joseph O. Parks* and to *their* heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Jacob W. Parks, and Joseph O. Parks* and to *their* heirs and assigns forever. as tenants in common and not as joint tenants
