To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Benjamin Franklin Blossom of Van Wert County Ohio
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Wayne
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Benjamin Franklin Blossom
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the South half of the South East quarter of Section Twenty Seven in Township Twenty Eight North
of Range Fourteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana
containing Eighty acres
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Benjamin Franklin Blossom.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress, in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Benjamin
Franklin Blossom and to his heirs, the said tract above described:
To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said
Benjamin Franklin Blossom and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Andrew JACKSON,
PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto
affixed.
