the North East fraction of the North East quarter of Section Eleven, in Township twenty eight of Range thirteen, in
the District of Fort Wayne (in) State of Indiana, Containing One acre and forty four hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said Rosanna Bushee

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several
acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Rosanna Bushee and

the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appur-
tenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Rosanna Bushee
and her
heirs and assigns forever.
