To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, *Jonas Clarke of Franklin County Indiana*
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Fort Wayne*
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Jonas Clarke*
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the Sixth East fraction of the North West Quarter and North Fraction of South West Quarter of Section Twelve, in Township
Twenty eight North, of Range Thirteen East, *in the system of lands subject to sale, as Fort Wayne Indiana* containing *Eighty four acres and Forty one hundredths of an acre*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Jonas Clarke*

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said *Jonas Clarke*
and to his heirs, the said tract above described:
To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said *Jonas Clarke*
and to his heirs and assigns forever.
