**CERTIFICATE**

**To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:**

**WHEREAS** *George Clinger of Ross County Ohio*

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Fort Wayne* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

*George Clinger* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North fraction of <sup>the</sup> South West quarter <sup>of the</sup> South East quarter of Section Twelve, the North fraction <sup>of the</sup> North East quarter of Section Thirteen in Township Twenty five North of range Thirteen East in the District of Land, subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing one hundred and eighty acres,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *George Clinger*

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the

**United States of America,** in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *George Clinger*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *George Clinger* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
