

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now Know De, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Andrew Coffman

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Andrew Coffman and taking

heirs and assigns forever.
