North West quarter of Section Fifteen, in Township
Twenty five North, of Range Fifteen East, in the
District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne,
Indiana, containing One Hundred and sixty
acres,

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said *Quarter* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

Theodore Crank, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
