having deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** a **WARRANT** in *his* favor, numbered *36,174*

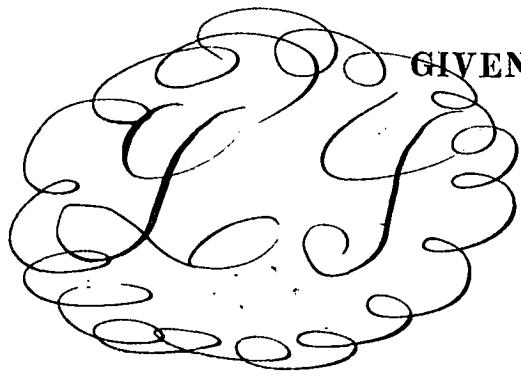
THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Jesse Cullison, of heirs of* said *Robert Gasaway,* and *his heirs,* the East half of the North East quarter, and the East half of the South East quarter of Section *Seven*, in Township *twenty five North,* of Range *fifteen East,* in the District of Lands subject to sale at *Fort Wayne Indiana* containing *One hundred and forty one acres and twenty hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL,** which said tracts have been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said *parts of said* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

Jesse Cullison, and his

heirs and assigns forever.
