To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Margaret O'Connor, Widow and heir at law of Robert O'Connor, deceased, late a private in Company "F" eleventh Regiment United States Infantry.

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in *her* favor, numbered 29425.

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Abriah Durbin, assigned* of said Margaret O'Connor, and to his heirs, the North East quarter of the South West quarter, and the North West quarter of the North East quarter and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section twelve, in Township twenty six, North of Range fourteen East, in the District of lands, subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing one hundred and twenty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Parts of said* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Abriah Durbin, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, *Millard Fillmore* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
