WHEREAS *David Eury of Frederick County, Maryland*

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at *Fort Wayne* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *David Eury*

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the South half of the North East quarter of Section three, and the South West quarter of Section ten, in Township twenty eight North, of Range thirteen East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing two hundred and thirty one acres and eighty six hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tracts has been purchased by the said *David Eury*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said *David Eury*

and to *his* heirs, the said tracts above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *David Eury*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
