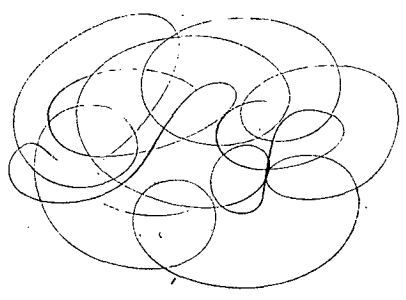
having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in *His* favor, numbered *84 C. A.*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said track & have been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Tracts* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John Fordyce, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
