To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS *Christian Kapp, of Adams County, Indiana,*

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Fort Wayne,* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Christian Kapp,*

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the South half of the North East quarter of Section ten, the East half of the North East quarter, and the East half of the South East quarter of Section fourteen, in Township twenty eight North, of Range thirteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing two hundred and forty acres,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Christian Kapp,*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *Christian Kapp,*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Christian Kapp,*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *Martin Van Buren,* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made **PATENT,** and the **SEAL** of the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.
