**To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:**

**WHEREAS** Lewis Kilbourn, of Portage County Ohio

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at Fort Wayne whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Lewis Kilbourn

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the North west quarter of Section one and South East quarter of Section Eleven in Township twenty eight, South of Range thirteen East in the District of Lands subject to Sale at Fort Wayne Indiana containing three hundred and five Acres, and twenty eight hundredths of an Acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said Lewis Kilbourn

**United States of America,** in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said Lewis Kilbourn

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Lewis Kilbourn

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
