the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South East quarter, <sup>and</sup> the South East fraction of the South West quarter, East and North of the *Wabash River*, of Section seventeen, in Township twenty five North of Range fourteen East, in the District of *Indiana* subject to sale at *Fort Wayne Indiana*, containing one hundred and forty nine acres, and seven hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Thomas Britchard*

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the

**United States of America,** in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *Joseph Logan*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Joseph Logan* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
