*William M Clelland* according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

*the West half, of the North East quarter, of Section Thirty-four, in Township Twenty-seven North, of Range Fourteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing eighty Acres*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *William M Clelland*

**United States of America,** in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED.** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *William M Clelland*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *William M Clelland*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
