KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Joseph Moser a Private in Captain Hornells Company of the First Regiment Ohio Volunteers

having deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** a **WARRANT** in *his* favor numbered *4494*

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *The said Joseph Moser* the east half of the south west Quarter and the west half of the south east quarter of Section two in Township Twenty six north of Range Fourteen east in the District of lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tracts have been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said *Half Quarter* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

Joseph Moser, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
