To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Jonas Pence, of Allen County Indiana has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Fort Wayne Indiana whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Jonas Pence, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South West quarter, of the North West quarter, of Section twenty seven, in Township twenty eight North, of Range fourteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing Fifty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Jonas Pence

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Jonas Pence and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Jonas Pence and to his heirs and assigns forever.
