Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North half of the North East quarter of Section Five, in Township Twenty Six North, of Range Fourteen East, in the district of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing Seventy acre and fifty six hundredths of an acre

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *George W. Ray*

and to his heirs and assigns forever
