fourteen East in the District of Lands subject  
to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana containing  
One hundred and twenty acres

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR**  
**GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said Daniel Sharretts

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
