Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850,

entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. *2163* for *80* acres,

issued in favor of *Andrew Stone private in Captain Sloan's company Third Regiment Ohio Militia War of 1812*

*North half of the North East quarter of Section Eleven Township Twenty six North of Range Thirteen East in the District of lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing Eighty acres*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

*Andrew Stone*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Andrew Stone and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
