at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing One hundred and
sixty three acres and seventy six hundredths of an acre,

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract have been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847; ^{*except paid for per Receiver's Receipt number 28,194.*} **TO HAVE AND**
