To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

*James Robinson,
Private Captain Henric's Company, Maryland and
District of Columbia Volunteers,*

having deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** a **WARRANT** in *his* favor, numbered *28.020.*

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Rezin Todd, assignee* of said James Robinson, and to his heirs, the North West quarter of the South East quarter, and the South half of the North East quarter, of Section Eleven, and the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section Twelve, in Township Twenty six, North, of Range Thirteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing *One hundred and sixty acres,*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tracts have been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND**

TO HOLD the said *parts of* sections of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

Rezin Todd, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
