according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the South half of Section thirty three, in Township twenty six North, of Range fourteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing three hundred and twenty Acres.

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Isaac Wannemacher

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
