To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Augustus Cain, late a Private in Captain Malace's Company of the Fourth Regiment Indiana Volunteers -

having deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** a **WARRANT** in *his* favor, numbered *12796-*

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *Willis C. Wilmore* Assignee of the said *Augustus Cain* - The South East ^{Quarter} of Section *thirty four* in Township *Twenty six* North of Range *Fifteen* East in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at *Fort Wayne* Indiana containing *One Hundred and Fifty six* Acres and *Sixteen* hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *tract* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Willis C. Wilmore*, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, *James K. Polk* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
