the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the West half of the North West quarter of Section twenty eight, and the East half of the North East quarter of Section twenty nine, in Township twenty seven North, of Range fifteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne Indiana, containing one hundred and fifty nine acres and ninety six hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracts have been purchased by the said Benjamin B. Winans

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Benjamin B. Winans

and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Benjamin B. Winans and to his heirs and assigns forever.
