the west half of section thirty four, in Township twenty five North, of Range thirteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing three hundred and twenty acres,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR**

such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights,

privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said James

Glendening

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
