

SCHINDLER, THEODORE KENYON

Captain, 737th Sq., 454th Group, 15th Air Force, 0-711 030. Born 1 Jan. 1922 at Berne, Ind., the son of John W. and Alieda (Sprunger) Schindler. Student at Butler University; residence, Berne. Enlisted 16 Sep. 1942 and entered service as an aviation cadet 28 Jan. 1943. Training: Sheppard Field, Tex., Emporia, Kans., Corsicana, Tex., Winfield, Kans., Pampa, Tex. Received his wings and was commissioned 8 Feb. 1944 at Pampa. Received transition training for B-24 pilots, Fort Worth, Tex., and overseas training, Casper, Wyo. Sent overseas Aug

1944. Based near Cerignola, Italy. Killed in action 28 Feb. 1945 while on his 30th bombing mission near Bressanone, Italy. Buried in U. S. Military Cemetery, Mirandola, Italy.
