

STAUB, FRED LEO

Second Lieutenant, Army Air Corps, 0-690 870. Born 30 May 1917 at Decatur, Ind., the son of Sylvester and Rosa (Hackman) Staub. Meat cutter, Decatur. Enlisted 22 Oct. 1941 at Fort MacArthur, Calif. Training: Air Corps Technical School, Keesler Field, Miss., Kelly

Field, Tex.; graduated from bombardier school, San Angelo Army Air Field, Tex. Sent overseas Mar. 1944. Was pilot-navigator. Missing 7 July 1944 when plane was shot down over Emden Harbor, Germany, while returning from bombing mission over Germany. Body was not recovered. Death confirmed 8 July 1945.
