

Roy D. Stucky, 88 of Bronson, MI, formerly of Monroe, IN died Thursday, July 25, 2013 at the Roudebush VA Medical Center, Indianapolis, IN. Roy was born on March 7, 1925 in Berne, IN to the late Florenz and Metta (Nussbaum) Stucky. On March 25, 1945 he married Mary Louise Trump. She preceded him in death on September 14, 2012.

Roy was a member of the East Ovid United Brethren Church in Coldwater, MI. He retired in 1988 from National Oil & Gas in Bluffton, IN. He served in the United States Army during World War II, serving from June 1943-February 1946 and was wounded

in action in Germany on December 12, 1944. He received the American Theater Ribbon, Eame Ribbon with 1 Bronze Star, Good Conduct Metal, Purple Heart and the Victory Metal.

Roy was preceded in death by four sisters and three brothers.
