which period hath now elapsed and the said
Frederick Meyers Sen. afterward to wit: on the
18th day of April ~~in~~ the year A.D. 1854 Indorsed
the said note to Joseph D. Nuttman Plaintiff
in this suit whereof the defendant then and there
had notice and then and there in consideration
of the premise ~~promised~~ promised to pay the amount
of said note to the Plaintiff according to the tenor

out benefit of the valuation or appraisement laws
