In this matter, it is agreed among the parties hereto, that the sum of fifty four dollars and eighty eight cents is the sum for distribution, and that the one equal half of said sum be paid by the Clerk of this Court, to the attorney of the Plaintiff, and the other half to the attorney of the Heirs at law of the Decedent, and it is expressly understood that this agreement is in ~~no~~^{no} way, or manner to affect or prejudice the rights of any of the parties in relation to the land of which the Decedent died seized, as the agreement is merely a compromise of the distribution of the proceeds of the personal estate, on the final administration of the Estate, that the content of the verdict of the Court of Decedent in this case, is no more to be affected by this agreement, than of no agreement whatever had been made between the parties.
