It is therefore ordered and adjudged and determined by the Court that said Settlement be regarded as a final settlement of said Guardianship and that said account be fully settled and allowed, the said Guardian now here presents and in open Court his Petition asking the Court among other things the Money due his pains to the said John Overholt which said Petition is in words & figures following to wit: State of Indiana Adams County ss.
 I, Nicholas Wagner Guardian of John Overholt, do hereby respectfully represent to the Court that said John Overholt is now twenty years of age and that he is married and needs the use of the Money due him, and that the Money he has paid into Court with his settlement the sum of fifty eight ⁵¹/₁₀₀ dollars for said Minor, the said Guardian asks the Court to accept said Settlement and order the Money paid to the said John Overholt.

 Which said Prayer of said Petition is granted by the Court and from a further examination of said Settlement Report & Petition the Court finds that the said Nicholas Wagner has paid into the Court with the said John Overholt's clerk of the Court the sum of Fifty Eight dollars & six cents for the use of said John Overholt and is married and needs the use of his Money for his support. It is therefore ordered and adjudged and determined by the Court that said sum of Money be paid to the said John Overholt and fifty six cents be paid over to the said John Overholt. And it is further ordered,

November Term 1859 the 3rd day

November 7th 1859

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by the Court that James McWhirter the Clerk of the Court pay
to the said John C. Overhart the said sum of Fifty Eight
dollars & sixty five cents and that the said Minor
John C. Overhart Receipt to the said Clerk of
the Court for the same and that the said Receipt
be Made on the Order book of the Court &
that said payment thus made to said John C. Overhart
the said Minor as aforesaid shall fully discharge
the said Clerk from any liability to the said ward
on his arriving at majority whereupon the said
Clerk now here in Open Court pays the said
sum of Fifty Eight dollars & sixty five cents
(so remaining in his hands for the said Minor) to the
said John C. Overhart for which said payment the
said John C. Overhart now here on the
Order Book of the Court gives his receipt
in words and figures following to wit: Received
of James McWhirter Clerk of the Court of Common
Pleas of Adams County Indiana the sum of
Fifty Eight dollars and sixty five cents the
full amount of the money paid to him by my
Guardian Nicholas Raign on the final settlement
of his Trust or Guardianship for me, which was settled
and allowed at the present term of the Court, this
the 9th day of November 1859, John C. Overhart

And the Court after having fully examined the premises
do Order adjudge and determine that said Guardian
be discharge from all further ^{or to the date of said settlement} accountability to the Court
or liability on his bond, ^{of which is ordered adjudge} and determined by the Court.

Eight O'clock A.M.
