State of Indiana, Adams County, ss:

I John S. Falk, Coroner of said county, having examined the body of Sam Haezger and heard the testimony of the witnesses, which said testimony is hereunto attached, do hereby find that the said deceased came to his death by premeditated suicide involuntarily and that gun in the head. Brain was blown out of the head. date of death was not known before was given to kill himself was not seen by any one signed Peter Haezger.  
Testimony of Joe Swartz  
I came home about 2:30 pm went to my grocery found Sam H. lying there dead. Did not touch anything called neighbors to help me. I found gun in my shed.  
Gun was still in same hand when I found him  
signed Joe Swartz.
