last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all other  
wills by me heretofore made.

It is my will and I hereby request that all of my just  
debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate.

After the payment of my debts and funeral expenses herein  
I give, devise and bequeath the residue of my estate, real, personal  
and mixed to my beloved wife, Magdalena Christner, this  
same to be her absolute and in fee simple.
