Last Will and Testament of Frances M. Campbell

Item 1. I do in my Will and I hereby provide that first of all all my just debts and the expense of my last sickness and my funeral expenses shall be paid out of my estate.

Item 2. After above items has been complied with then I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Abell all my same held goods in one word all my personal property consisting of horses and cattle and Farming implements of all descriptions whatsoever it may be that it may die possessed of.

Item 3. I give and Bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Abell the westward one half 1/2 of my Real Estate to some being the North East quarter 1/4 of the South West quarter of section 23 thirty three township twenty eight 28 north range 14 East in Adams County, Indiana.

Item 4. I give and bequeath to my son Willis M. Campbell and daughter Minnie F. unless the remaining half of my above described Real Estate.

Item 5. I hereby appoint my Daughter Elizabeth Abell as Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
