I, Bernard J. Server of Adams County, Indiana, being of sound mind & memory do make & publish this my last will & testament hereby revoking all former wills by me heretofore made.

Item 1. It is my will first that all of my just debts & of general expenses & expenses of last sickness be paid as soon as practical.

Item 2. I give & bequeath to the Pastor of Saint Mary's Roman Catholic Church at Decatur, Indiana the sum of One Hundred Dollars for Masses for me to be paid out of ~~my~~ my estate as soon as practical.

Item 3. After the payment of the above & foregoing as provided in Items 1 & 2 of this will, I give & bequeath the residue of my property both real & personal & whate'er she receive whatsoever to my beloved wife Mary Server, she to receive the rents & profits therefrom with full power to use, convey sell & dispose of the same as she may see fit, with full power to use the proceeds of such sale or sales or conveyances in any manner that she may see fit.

Item 4. It is my further will that upon the death of my wife Mary Server there shall be first paid out & given of whatever of said property if any that remains the following amounts to the following of my children to-wit:
To my daughter Mary Server \$1,000.00
To my daughter Clara White \$500.00
To my daughter Emma Sawlings \$500.00

To my son Bernard J. Server, Lots 47 & 49 in Block One in Moore subdivision in the City of Chicago in the State of Illinois, which is the real estate owned by me in the City of Chicago, Ill; and he shall receive such lots in fee simple & the same are hereby given & bequeathed to him in fee simple. But if said lots should be disposed of by my said before her death, then my said son Bernard shall be paid in cash from my estate the full value of such lots the same to be determined by what said lots have sold for if sold.
