Mrs. Anna Peters Dies This Morning
Jefferson Township Woman Dies Today

Mrs. Anna Peters, 66, wife of Fred Peters and a lifelong resident of Adams and Wells Counties, died this morning at 4:30 o'clock at her home in Jefferson Township. She had been ill one year.

The deceased was born in Preble Township, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. William Hilgemann. She was married December 28, 1905.

Surviving besides the husband are a son, Elmer of Ossian; two daughters, Edna of Sheboygan, Wis., and Mrs. Alvin Huth of Frankton; a brother, John Hilgemann of Route One, Decatur and a sister, Mrs. Ed Reppert of Decatur.

A brother and three sisters preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Magley Reformed Church of which she was a member, following a service at 1:30 o'clock at the home. Rev. Matthew Worthman of Bluffton will officiate. Burial will be in the church cemetery.

The body will be removed from the Jahn Funeral Home in Bluffton to the residence Thursday noon and may be viewed there until time for the services.
