...DIES THIS MORNING

K. R. Wolf Dies At Fort Wayne Today

K. R. Wolf, 67, Fort Wayne merchant for the last 20 years, and father of Mrs. Felix Maier of this city, died at 8:20 o'clock this morning at St. Joseph's hospital, Fort Wayne, after a week's illness. Death resulted from complications.

Mr. Wolf and his family moved to Fort Wayne from Huntington 20 years ago, and he had resided in that city since.

Surviving, besides the widow, are the following children: Katherine, at home; Mrs. Harold Sachs, Chicago; Mrs. Felix Maier, Decatur and Maurice Wolf, Fort Lewis, Wash. Four sisters, two brothers, and three grandchildren of Cincinnati and Mrs. Wolf's mother, aged 93, also of Cincinnati, survive.

Funeral services and burial will be made in Fort Wayne, probably Friday.
