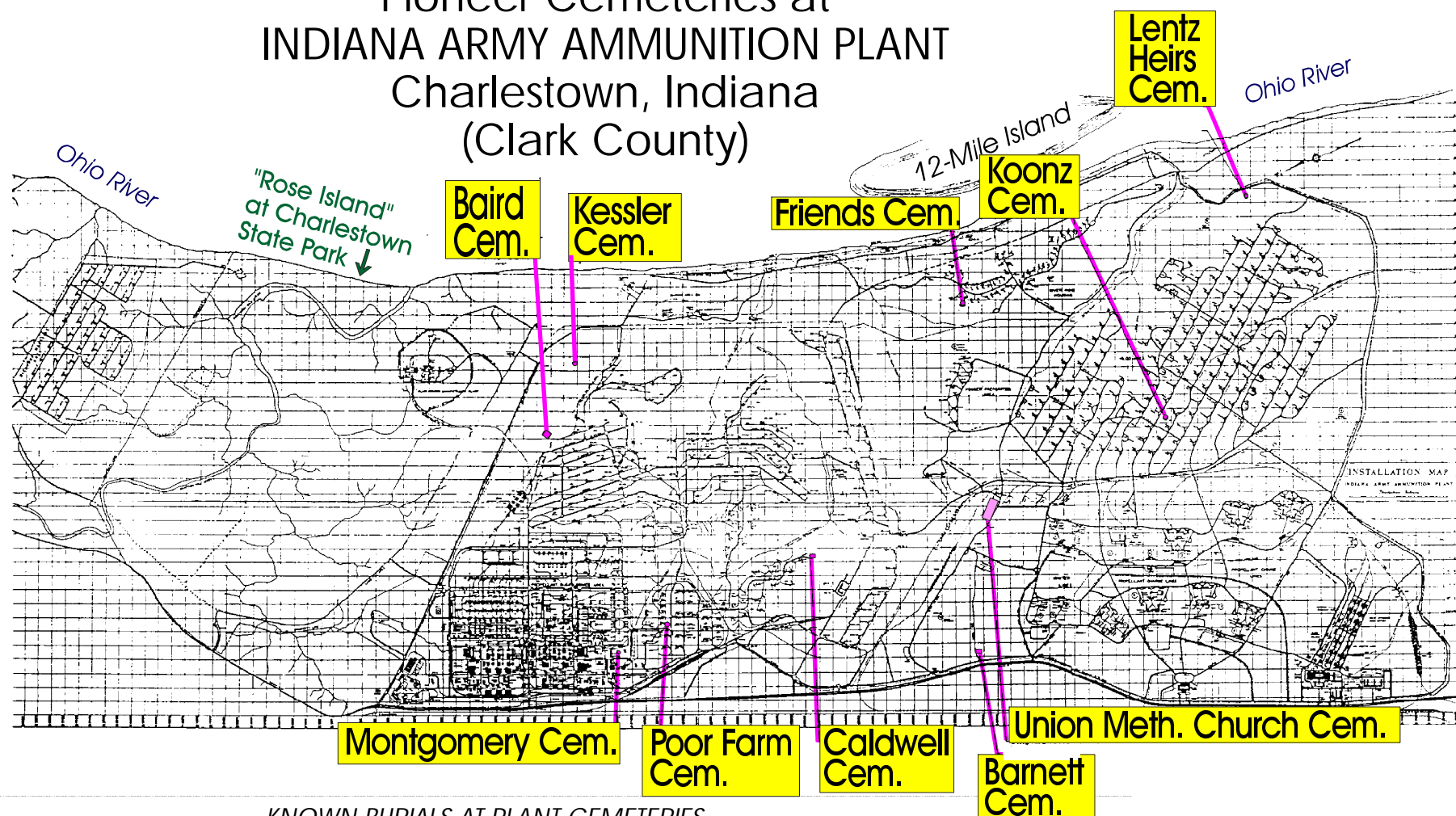


Pioneer Cemeteries at INDIANA ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT Charlestown, Indiana (Clark County)



KNOWN BURIALS AT PLANT CEMETERIES

KESSLER Cemetery (North Patrol Road): FERGUSON and KING
 BAIRD Cemetery (off 8th Street): HUCKLEBERRY, REED, STRUTT, GIBSON, ASBERRY, CARNEY, BROWN, MURRAY, BLYTH, TROXEL, JANEWAY and YOUNG
 CALDWELL Cemetery (17th Street): PRATHER and LUTZ
 KOONZ Cemetery (H Avenue): SPANGLER
 LENTZ HEIRS Cemetery (South Patrol Road): SUMMERS and HOBSON
 BARNETT Cemetery (Reservoir Patrol Road): HILTIBIDAL, BLIZZARD, ATCHISON and YOUNG
 FRIENDS Cemetery (River Ridge): HAWN, RILEY, DAILY, BELL and SHIELDS
 MONTGOMERY Cemetery (12th St. and F Ave.): No legible stones in 1997
 POOR FARM Cemetery (14th St. and G Ave.): No stones remain in 1997
 UNION Cemetery (Water Line Road): Over 600 burials; records at Charlestown Library

NOTE: These family cemeteries were named by the federal government based on the surnames of the property owners at the time of the condemnation circa 1940, NOT the names of the persons buried there.
